

# NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Only original papers will be published and a copy of the Copyright Transfer Statement will be sent to the authors of papers accepted for publication. Manuscripts will be processed only after receiving the signed copy of the statement.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Two copies of the manuscript and two sets of the figures should be submitted to:

Manuscripts in English including Abstract, Literature, Tables and Captions should be typed double-spaced (25 lines, 50 characters per line including spaces) and supplied with authors' names, page number. Tables should be on separate, numbered pages after the Literature. Captions, on a separate page, should follow the tables. Acta Phytopathologica requests authors to submit the manuscript also on a CD. The disk must contain all final revisions. Tabular material as well as text should be included on the disk.

## FORMAT

- Title* The title should reflect the most important aspects of the article, in a preferably concise form of not more than 100 characters and spaces.
- By-line* The authors' names should be followed by affiliations and addresses. (No inclusion of scientific titles is necessary.)
- Abstracts* are required for all the manuscripts. They should be typed in one paragraph and limited to max. 200 words.

- Keywords* Most important words of paper.
- Text* Major sections after the introductory statements are: Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Literature. Subheadings may be used, though the unnecessary fragmentation of the text should be omitted.
- Figures* Line-drawing should be clear and of high quality. Cite all figures in numerical order in the manuscript. Captions should describe the contents so that each illustration is understandable when considered apart from the text. Each illustration should be labelled with the figure number, author's name, and *Acta Phytopathologica*.  
High-quality glossy prints of photographs should be cropped at right angles to show only essential details. Insert a scale bar where necessary to indicate magnification. Submit two sets of prints of equivalent quality.
- Tables* The title should be self-explanatory and include enough information so that each table is intelligible without reference to the text or other tables. The title should summarize the information presented in the table without repeating the subheadings. Subheadings should be brief (abbreviations are acceptable), nonstandard ones can be explained in footnotes. Cite tables in numerical order in the manuscript. Information presented in a table should agree with that in the text.
- Literature* List literature cited in alphabetic order by authors' surnames. The list should contain names and initials of all the authors (et al. is not accepted here); for journal articles year of publication, the title of the paper, title of the journal abbreviated (do not abbreviate one word titles), volume number, first and last page. Hungarian titles should be translated in parantheses.  
For books or chapters of books, the titles are followed by the publisher as well as place and date of publication.
- Examples:*

Authors can use the **OOpenArt (optional open article)** publication model for a specific publishing fee. Full-text of an OOpenArt paper is freely accessible through the official website of the journal. These papers are also published in the printed journals as well as all the traditional ones. Peer-review process and quality requirements are the same in case of both traditional and OOpenArt manuscripts. Both accepted new manuscripts and papers published earlier can be OOpenArt.

The price of an OOpenArt article is **900 EUR (1260 USD) + VAT**, where applicable, but it can be even less. Akadémiai Kiadó offers **50% discount** for corresponding authors of **a)** subscribing institutions, **b)** Hungarian institutions, **c)** institutions of low- and middle-income countries. Discounts may not be combined, all these authors should pay **450 EUR (630 USD)**. The above OOpenArt fee does not include any normal (excess) page fees and colour charges.

By executing the Optional Open Article Agreement and paying the OOpenArt fee the Author retains the ownership and further rights related to the Article while ensures the wide accessibility of the Article in the written and electronic media controlled by Akadémiai Kiadó.
